The purpose of the Committee:

To review and advise Council on the Waste Management Strategy, including the goal to stop the current practice of burning and dumping waste at Headstone.

Membership

Includes a maximum of 8 voting members consisting of:

One (1) Councillor

One (1) Representative from EcoNorfolk

Two (2) Representatives from Tourism Accommodation

One (1) Chamber of Commerce representative

Two (2) Community Members

Members must be interested in the reduction of waste through minimisation of waste, and have expertise/interest in waste management in general for the whole of Norfolk Island and not for self-interest only.

Applicants should highlight their suitability for the role through the provision of a cover letter which details which body they are representing (this could be community member), resume and any other supporting documentation.
