2 SUSPENSION OF STANDING ORDERS

Mr Gardner, Chief Minister, moved –

THAT so much of Standing Orders be suspended as would prevent the House from only dealing with the matters listed on the Programme

Question put and agreed to on the voices in accordance with Standing Order 244

3 FUEL EMERGENCY BILL 2005

Mr Gardner, Chief Minister, moved –

THAT so much of standing orders be suspended as would prevent -

a) **my introducing a Bill for an Act to provide for the control and management of fuel in periods of emergency and purposes associated therewith, and for the Bill to be considered through all stages at this sitting; and**

b) **the Bill from being considered through all stages at this sitting**

Question put and agreed to on the voices in accordance with Standing Order 244

Mr Gardner presented a Bill for an Act to provide for the control and management of fuel in periods of emergency and purposes associated therewith and moved –

THAT the Bill be agreed to in principle

Paper: Mr Gardner tabled the Explanatory Memorandum to the Bill

THAT clause 4 of the Bill be amended by replacing the words “executive member” wherever appearing with the word “Administrator”

Question – That the remainder of the Bill be agreed to – put and agreed to on the voices

Mr Gardner moved –

THAT the Bill as amended be agreed to

Debate ensued

Question put

Bill as amended agreed to on the voices
