"That this House recommends that, pursuant to sub-section 8(2) of the Public Service Ordinance 1979, His Honour the Administrator appoint RONALD DOUGLAS MALCOLM to be Chief Administrative Officer, with effect from 1 November 1983, upon the terms and conditions applicable to that office as determined by His Honour by instrument dated 26 September 1983".

Paper: Mr. Buffett, in speaking to the motion, laid on the Table of the House a paper entitled "Report by D.E. Buffett, B.G. Bates and P.A. Page proposing the appointment of a Chief Administrative Officer".
