MINUTES OF PROCEEDINGS

WEDNESDAY 15 JULY 1992

1 The Legislative Assembly met at 10.00 am. Mr President (Hon J T Brown) took the Chair and announced he proposed to await the arrival of certain members before reading the Prayer.

2 **TABLING OF REGULATIONS**

Mr. President laid on the Table of the House the Norfolk Island Government Tourist Bureau Amendment Regulations 1992.

3 **VISITOR IN PUBLIC GALLERY**

Mr. Bates invited the attention of the House to the presence in the public gallery of Mr Max Shackleton, owner of a Travel Agency in Noumea responsible for selling Norfolk Island in New Caledonia.

4 **WANT OF QUORUM**

Mr President informed the House that he had waited 5 minutes for the arrival of Mr Robinson and Mr Sanders and that he was not satisfied that they would arrive within a reasonable time.

Mr President further advised the House that he had formed a view that three persons presently in the Chamber had as a matter of law vacated their offices as Members and that accordingly, in accordance with standing order 35, he adjourned the House until Wednesday 26 August 1992 at 10.00 am.
