FRIDAY 17 MARCH 1995

- 1 The Legislative Assembly met at 3.00 pm. Mr President (Hon D E Buffett) took the Chair and read the Prayer

- 2 **LEAVE OF ABSENCE HON M W KING MLA**
Leave of absence from the meeting was extended to the Hon Mike King MLA

- 3 **DISPENSATION OF BUSINESS BEFORE THE HOUSE**
Mr Christian (Minister for the Environment), by leave, moved -

 THAT consideration of the business before the House be dispensed with other than the matter of determining the specific question to be addressed at referendum to ascertain the opinion of the electors in respect of the establishment of a quarantine station on Norfolk Island

 Question put and agreed to unanimously

- 4 **REFERENDUM - DETERMINATION OF QUESTION**
Mr Christian (Minister for the Environment), by leave, moved -

 THAT the following question be put to the electors at referendum:

 Are you in favour of a quarantine facility for alpacas being established in Norfolk Island, subject to conditions reflected in the resolution of the Legislative Assembly on 15th March 1995?

 Debate ensued
 Question put and agreed to unanimously

- 5 **STATEMENT BY PRESIDENT**
The President advised the House that the electoral roll would close on 5 April 1995 and that polling day for the referendum was 3 May 1995

6 **FIXING OF NEXT SITTING DAY**
Mr Bennett (Minister for Finance) moved -

THAT the House confirms its decision of 15 March 1995 to adjourn, on rising, until Wednesday 12 April 1995 at 10 am

Question put and agreed to unanimously

Mrs Lozzi-Cuthbertson (Minister for Health and Education) moved -

THAT the House do now adjourn

Question put and agreed to unanimously
