1 The Legislative Assembly met at 10.01 am. Mr Speaker (Hon D E Buffett) took the Chair and read the Prayer

2 **DISPENSATION OF BUSINESS BEFORE THE HOUSE**

Mrs Lozzi Cuthbertson (Minister for Health and Education), by leave, moved -

THAT consideration of the business before the House be dispensed with other than the matter of Extension of Appointment of the Chief Administrative Officer

3 **EXTENSION OF APPOINTMENT OF THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER**

Mr King (Minister for Tourism and Finance), by leave, moved -

THAT this House rescinds the Resolution of the Legislative Assembly, described as Item No 11 in the Minutes of Proceedings of 13th September 1995 headed "EXTENSION OF APPOINTMENT OF THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER"

and

THAT this House recommends to His Honour the Administrator that, in pursuance of section 8 of the Public Service Ordinance 1979, he vary as follows, the terms and conditions of the appointment of Eric Roy Mitchell as Chief Administrative Officer as determined by the Deputy Administrator on 26 March 1993 and varied by the Administrator on 25 October 1994:

Clause 1 - Period of Appointment

Omit "for two years and six months, commencing on 19 April 1993" and substitute "from 19 April 1993 to 26 November 1995".

Clause 4 - Gratuity in Lieu of Superannuation and Long Service Leave

Omit subclause 4(1) and substitute the following:

"4. (1) The officer shall receive a gratuity, in lieu of superannuation and long service leave, payable at the end of the completed term of employment. The amount of the gratuity shall be a sum equal to 10% of the annual salary actually payable at the end of the term of employment multiplied by the duration of the term of employment expressed in terms of numbers of years and fractions of a year."

Debate ensued
