MEDIA RELEASE: *Norf'k CIRCA* meets to discuss move uptown

The *Norf'k Community Information & Resources Cooperative Association (CIRCA) Inc* will meet next week to discuss plans for a move of Norfolk's newest community information resource to Burnt Pine in the near future. All members of CIRCA are invited to attend the next meeting, which will be held at the A & H Hall at 5.00 p.m. on Thursday 22nd January. The not-for-profit incorporated association is planning to relocate to a readily accessible site in Burnt Pine, with a view to eventually expanding to become a comprehensive community information centre.

Membership of CIRCA is free and is open to all persons or organisations ordinarily resident in Norfolk Island. CIRCA has already established a wide network of more than 80 local email contacts, who have received up to 15 regular free information updates on a wide range of areas of interest. These include government and private research reports, calls for submissions to committees and inquiries, details of government and community services and information on a wide range of funding programs, many of which are applicable to small remote communities, such as Norfolk Island.
