# **Hand in number plates now for unregistered and uninsured vehicles**

The Registrar of Motor Vehicles has reminded members of the community about the current police campaign to deal with motor vehicles which are unregistered and uninsured. Norfolk Island Police are checking vehicles to ensure compliance with the *Road Traffic Act 1982* requiring the registration and insurance of all motor vehicles.

The Registrar has advised that the moratorium on return of number plates from unregistered vehicles will cease at the end of April.

Those persons who have number plates that are no longer required are requested to return them to the Cashier at the Administration, Kingston, to avoid incurring any fees. At the end of April 2009 those persons who retain such number plates will be invoiced for the non-return of the plates.

The public are therefore urged to ensure that their motor vehicle is registered and to return to the Cashier any other number plates surplus to requirements no later than 30<sup>th</sup> April 2009.
